NURSERY CAREGIVER STUDENT LEADER

Time Commitment: 1 Year – 1.5 hours per week

Every Week Every Other Week Once A Month

A student leader in the nursery is a volunteer in training. You will be mentored by an adult nursery caregiver. Student leaders are committed to attending at least one service per week and volunteering in a nursery classroom during another service. You will need to have your leader in High School Ministry sign a letter stating that you are attending Ignite, a D-Group or other service. A student leader loves Jesus, babies and toddlers and desires to help out adult caregivers as they minister to these small children. Student leaders must be friendly and helpful.

After you fill out a ministry volunteer application, you will be paired up with an experienced volunteer who will guide and mentor you while providing on the job training. You may wish to “shadow” a volunteer in many areas of children’s ministry until you find the right fit. If your right fit is a nursery caregiver, you will then be assigned to a Service Coordinator who will be your mentor and ensure that you are properly equipped.

You must be 16 years old to volunteer in the birth – 12 month classrooms. 15 years and younger may serve in all other nursery classrooms.
