JOB DESCRIPTION

Time Commitment: 1 Year – 1.5 hours per week

Every Week 1st & 3rd Weeks 2nd & 4th Weeks

A worship leader is someone who is dedicated to the missions' of The Chapel and its' Children's Ministry. You are responsible for setting the tone of worship for preschool or elementary children. You need to be able to create energy and incite crowd participation while leading kids in worship music. All music needs to be memorized and may include choreography. Stage presence and a good singing voice are necessary. This volunteer position may require an audition. The elementary worship leader position will require an additional time for rehearsal each week. All music is selected by the Chapel Kids staff and is available one month in advance.

After you fill out a ministry volunteer application, you will be paired up with an experienced volunteer who will guide and mentor you while providing on the job training. You may wish to "shadow" a volunteer in many areas of children's ministry until you find the right fit. If your right fit is a worship leader, you will then be assigned to a Service Coordinator who will be your mentor and ensure that you are properly equipped. You must be in the 6th grade or older to serve.
